Subject: Exercise of the data subject's rights pursuant to Articles 15 et seq. of EU Regulation 679/16 (General Data Protection Regulation - GDPR).

ASKS

in relation to the personal data processed by you, to exercise the rights indicated below.

Right of revocation of consent (Art. 13(2)(c) GDPR): You have the right to revoke your consent at any time for all processing operations for which the legitimacy of the processing (the so-called legal basis) is your manifestation of consent. Revocation of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent before revocation, nor does it affect the retention of data that Zapi s.p.a. is obliged to keep.

Specify personal data and type of processing/purpose

Right of access (Art. 15 GDPR): You have the right to request confirmation of the existence of the processing of your personal data as well as to obtain the following information: (a) the purposes of the processing; (b) the categories of personal data being processed; (c) the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be disclosed, in particular if recipients from Third Countries or international organisations; (d) when possible, the period for which the personal data are to be retained or, if this is not possible, the criteria used to determine that period; (e) the existence of the right to request from the data controller the rectification or erasure of personal data or the restriction of the processing of personal data concerning you or to object to their processing; (f) the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority; (g) where the data are not collected from the data subject, all available information on their origin; (h) the

existence of an automated decision-making process, including profiling as referred to in Article 22(1) and (4) GDPR, and, at least in such cases, meaningful information on the logic used, as well as the importance and the expected consequences of such processing for the data subject.

Indicate the information requested and any request for a copy of personal data

[] Right of rectification (Art. 16 GDPR): You have the right to request the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you and to obtain the integration of incomplete personal data.

Specify the data whose rectification or supplementation is required and the corrected data

[] Right to erasure - oblivion (Art. 17 GDPR): You have the right to obtain the erasure of personal data concerning you if the personal data is no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which it was collected or otherwise processed, if you withdraw your consent and there is no other legal basis for the processing, if you object to the processing pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR and there is no overriding legitimate ground for processing, or objects to processing for direct marketing purposes, if the data has been unlawfully processed, if there is a legal obligation to erase the data. Please note that pursuant to Article 17(3) GDPR, a request cannot be granted if the processing is necessary for the exercise of the right to freedom of expression and information, for the fulfilment of a legal obligation or for the establishment, exercise or defence of a legal claim.

Specifying personal data and the reasons for exercising the right to be forgotten

[] Right of restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR): You have the right to obtain the restriction of processing where you have contested the accuracy of personal data, during the period necessary for the controller to verify the accuracy of such personal data, if the processing is unlawful and the data subject, instead of requesting that the data be erased, has requested that its use be restricted, or although the personal data are no longer necessary to the controller for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims, if the data subject has exercised his right to object, pending the controller's assessment.

Specify the personal data and the reasons for exercising the right to limitation.

[] Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR): You have the right to receive in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format the personal data concerning you that you have provided to the data controller and you have the right to transmit those data to another data controller without hindrance from the data controller

to whom you have provided them where the processing is based on consent or contract and the processing is carried out by automated means.

Specify the personal data for which the right to portability is being exercised.

[] Right to object (Art. 21 GDPR): You have the right to object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to the processing of data relating to you that is necessary for the purposes of pursuing a legitimate interest of the controller, unless the controller demonstrates the existence of compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims. You also have the right to object at any time to processing for direct marketing purposes.
